■ DISTRIBUTION ■

Products are distributed from logistics centres located with a view to optimize transport efficiency. The Reference Product is therefore transported over an average distance of 300 km by road from our warehouse to the local point of distribution into the Turkish market. Packaging is compliant with applicable regulation. At their end of life, its recyclability rate is 95 % (in % of packaging weight).
