
Box 80 x 80






Box 105 x 105

5. REGULATIONS GOVERNING SAFETY CIRCUITS IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS

Cat. No(s).: 920 15/25/45

Article EL 16 Power supply circuits for safety installations

- §1. In addition to the provisions of Article EL 10, the power supply ducts for safety installations must meet the following provisions:
- a) they must be category CR 1 from the safety source or the main panel down to the terminal equipment; the corresponding derivation or junction devices and their enclosures except for weatherproofing devices must satisfy the glow wire test defined in the applicable standards, the temperature of the glow wire being 960°C;
- b) The premises at particular risk of fire as stated in Article CO 27 must not be crossed by safety installation ducts other than those intended to supply equipment located in these premises;
- c) The safety installation cables must be different from the normal/replacement installation cables.
